Destination – Skate!

March 20, 21 and 22, 2020

The Wyandotte Figure Skating Club and the Wyandotte Learn to Skate Program are pleased to host the **2020 Ice Travaganza – Destination - Skate!** We will be getting our passports ready and flying across the world to many different and exciting destinations.

Our show director this year is Stephanie Senterfit Riker. Stephanie has been skating since the age of 3 and has 30 plus years of ice show skating experience. She is the 2014 U.S. Adult Figure Skating National Champion, 2018 National silver medalist, 4-time sectionals champion and hold numerous other national and sectional medals! Stephanie has 20 plus years of coaching experience, directed Ice Travaganza 2019, *Under the Big Top*, and has been with Wyandotte Figure Skating Club since 2014.

DRESS REHEARSAL AND ICE SHOW DATES AND TIMES

All skaters are required to skate in all performances, practices and dress rehearsals. The show dates and times will be:

- Friday, March 20 at 7:00 p.m.
- March 21 at 2:00 and 7:30 p.m.
- Sunday, March 22 at 2:30 p.m.

Dress rehearsal dates and times will be:

- Tuesday, March 17, 6 to 9 p.m. – First Half with costumes – arrive by 5:30 p.m.
- Wednesday, March 18, 6 to 9 p.m. – Second Half with costumes – arrive by 5:30 p.m.
- Thursday, March 19, 5 to 8:30 p.m. – Both halves with costumes – arrive by 4:30 p.m.

Skaters will be grouped into their respective groups based on their skill level and age. All skaters will participate in the Grand Finale. Those skaters who wish to skate additional numbers will be placed in segments based on their skating level and ability.

MEETINGS & PRACTICES

A mandatory parent meeting will be held once all registrations are in – date and time to be announced! Practices will begin in early 2020. Dates and times will be announced once all groups have been finalized. Skaters must attend all practices. Each number will have a minimum of 6 practice sessions along with floor practices at the coach's discretion.

ICE SHOW REGISTRATION DATES: NOVEMBER 2, 6, 9, 13, 16, 20 AND 23.

Due to costume ordering deadlines, early registration will close on November 23, 2019. Late registrations will be accepted if costumes are available for the group number that the skater would be assigned to; costume availability for late registrants cannot be guaranteed. There is an additional \$25 late registration fee due to additional costs incurred for ordering costumes past the registration due date. Registration fees include costume, one pair of tights (for first number), ice time and coaching for group numbers and finale. Additional numbers' fees do not include tights, however additional tights may be purchased for \$16 per pair and is highly recommended.

For those skaters in more than one number, registration fees will be split in to three payments, with the first payment of \$115 due at registration, the second payment of \$70 due by January 11, 2020 and the remaining balance due by February 8, 2020. Payments must be made by personal check, cashier's check or money order made payable to WFSC. Absolutely no cash will be accepted.

MANDATORY FUND RAISING

Putting on an ice show is an expensive feat, and fund raising is an essential part of the success of Ice Travaganza. There are three required fund-raising drives that will be held for the show and are as follows:

1. Show Tickets: This year, it is our goal to fill the stands and on-ice seating! Skaters are required to sell a minimum of 10 show tickets per family – but please feel free to sell more! Pre-sale ticket costs will be \$7 per adult and \$5 for children 12 and under and seniors. Tickets purchased at the show will be \$8 per adult ticket and \$6 for children 12 and under and seniors. Children 3 and under will be free and do not require a ticket. Payment for ticket sales are due by Saturday, March 7 by money order, personal check or cashier's check made payable to WFSC.
2. Program Book Ads: A program book will be created and sold at the show. It will include pictures of all groups and special parts involved in the show. Special parts skaters are required to sell a minimum \$100 in program book ads per family and can be a combination of any size ads including personal ads. All other skaters are required to sell a minimum of \$50 in program book ads per family and can be a combination of any size ads including personal ads. Ad costs are as follows:
 - Full page - \$100
 - Half page - \$50
 - Quarter page - \$30
 - Business card (NO PHOTOS) - \$20

All ads are due by January 25, 2020.

3. Ice Travaganza will have a Dearborn Sausage fund raiser to help support the expenses of our show. Every family in the show is expected to participate and sell a minimum of \$100 in ham orders. The fund raiser will begin prior to the show, with delivery in time for Easter 2020.

If a family chooses to not participate in this third required fund raising activity, they can choose to pay a buy-out of \$75 in lieu of fund raising. Selling show tickets and program book ads are still required fundraisers for ALL skaters.

REQUIRED VOLUNTEERING

Ice Travaganza is a volunteer-run show and can only be successful with the help of our skaters' families. Volunteering a minimum of two shows is required per family; additional help is encouraged! In addition, special parts skaters/families are required to volunteer a minimum of 10 hours at the prop garage.

This year, we will be using Sign-Up Genius to coordinate our volunteers. Please provide us with the name and email addresses of anyone that is willing to help us with the show! We will be looking for the following:

Registration will close November 23, 2019. Late registrations will be accepted if costumes are available for the group number that the skater would be assigned to; costume availability for late registrants cannot be guaranteed. There is an additional \$25 late registration fee per number due to additional costs incurred for separate costume ordering costs. The registration fee of \$115 includes costume, one pair of tights, ice time and coaching for one group number and finale. Snowplow Sam skaters' registration fee is \$90 includes costume, one pair of tights, ice time and coaching for one group number and finale. Special parts skaters must have their private coach choreograph their number. Additional requirements for special parts skaters are noted in special part try-out materials. Those skaters receiving a special part are required to pay \$75 for this additional part; Soloists fees are \$30 plus the cost of their costume that is approved by the director. Soloist fees for costumes are dependent on the cost of the costume selected and payment in full is expected for the costume by December 28, 2019. Skaters with special parts are required to register for the show by November 15, 2019 to secure their special part.

For those skaters in more than one number, registration fees will be split in to three payments, with the first payment of \$115 due at registration, the second payment of \$70 due by January 11, 2020 and the remaining balance due by February 8, 2020. Payments must be made by personal check, cashier's check or money order made payable to WFSC. Absolutely no cash will be accepted

Additional tights can be purchased for \$17 per pair. We highly recommend purchasing a second pair of tights.

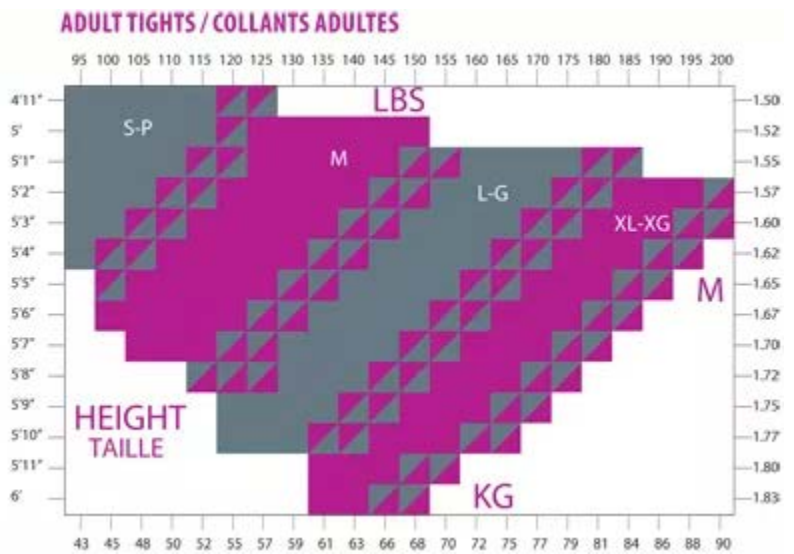
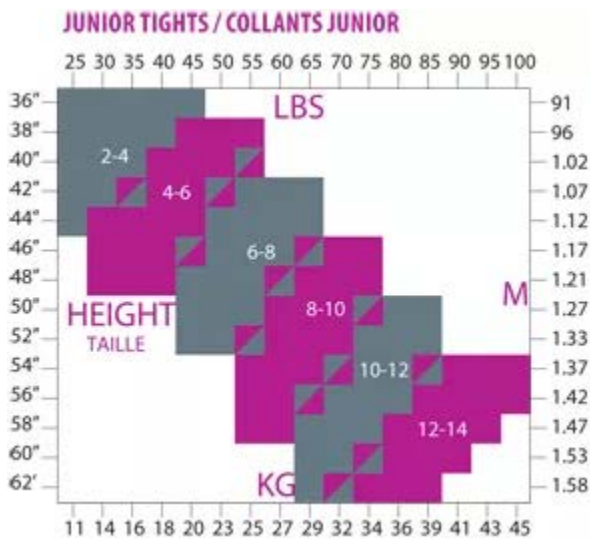
